

Large Ribbed Hat

I have always had trouble when it comes to decreasing on my ribbed hats. I just never could make it look right. I finally tried it with a K3, P3 rib and was thrilled with the top.

Materials: 5 oz of yarn, 2 kinds of 4 ply worsted weight yarn or 1 kind of chunky yarn, Size 13 needles

Directions:

NOTE: Hat is worked holding 2 strand of yarn at the same time or 1 strand of very chunky yarn. This hat can be knit in the round or knit flat and sewn together.

Cast on 60 st

Row 1: Knit 3, Purl 3

Continue in this pattern until hat is at least 8 in long (10in give a nice thick brim)

Decreasing

Row 1: K, Ktog, P, Ptog repeat till end

Row 2: K2, P2, repeat till end

Row 3: Ktog, Ptog, repeat till end

Finishing

Cut yarn, place on yarn needle and thread through remaining stitches, pull to draw shut and form the top, if knit flat use remaining yarn to sew the side seam, weave in all ends
